Solar Eclipse Eye Safety

Looking directly at the sun during a solar eclipse is unsafe, except during a brief phase when the moon entirely blocks the sun's bright face. This phase is called totality. The path of totality for tomorrow's eclipse stretches from Oregon to South Carolina. Unless you're in the path of totality, keep your solar eclipse glasses on throughout the eclipse. Four manufacturers have certified that their eclipse glasses and handheld solar viewers meet the standards for eye protection: Rainbow Symphony, American Paper Optics, thousand Oaks Optical and TSE 17.
